Google Integration in the Assignment Tool

- One log-in needed
- Individual file copies for every student
- Available for all organizations with a connected G Suite for Education domain

Creating an assignment

1. Connected Drive account will automatically open when a Google Doc is added
2. Multiple docs can be added, with one as template
3. Students can start answering



Grading the assignment

1. The answer will open in the new “all-in-one-grader”
2. Teachers can view and give feedback
3. Teachers can comment in a new window by clicking “Open Google Docs”
4. Teachers can enable resubmissions
